- 4. How many third grade or fourth grade tears sustained during childbirth were recorded in the last five years?
- 5. Of these injuries, how many patients were referred to perinatal and pelvic health physiotherapy services?
- 6. Of these injuries, how many patients were still being followed up for ongoing care after 2 years?
- 7. Of these injuries, how many resulted in a serious incident investigation being raised?
- 8. Of these injuries, how many were recorded as 'never events'.
- 9. Of these injuries, how many patients received Duty of Candour notifications?
- 10. How many readmissions post-birth were recorded in the last five years related to bladder injuries?
- 11. How many readmissions post-birth were recorded in the last five years related to anal sphincter injuries?
- 12. How many readmissions post-birth were recorded in the last five years related to third grade or fourth grade tears sustained during childbirth?
